RELEASED BILLFISH RECORDING

Each boat must PHOTOGRAPH released Billfish with a camera provided by the vessel. The photograph must include the designated DAILY RIBBON and BILLFISH in view and in a position that constitutes a release. It is the responsibility of the boat to collect a new ribbon each fishing day, available at the Weigh-In area at 4 AM. Each boat is required to keep their billfish photograph on their camera until Saturday, July 16, 2010. All boats are subject to random photography checks throughout the tournament. Leading boats will be required to submit their camera and/or chips to the Tournament Rules Committee following fishing on Saturday, July 10, 2010. Fish verification will be at the sole discretion of the Tournament Rules Committee.

In addition, Billfish affidavits **MUST BE SIGNED** by all anglers 18 years and older in a boat upon a Billfish release. By signing the affidavit, anglers are consenting to polygraph testing. Affidavits will be distributed and collected along side your slip by Tournament and SCDNR representatives.

POLYGRAPH TESTING will be administered at the sole discretion of the Tournament Rules Committee. Refusal by any participant will result in disqualification. Interpretation and conclusion by professionals administering the test are final.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE ABOVE RULES, AND AGREE TO ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS. I WILL VERBALIZE THESE RULES TO STATED VESSEL'S CREW PRIOR TO FISHING DAYS AND POST THE ATTACHED COPY OF THESE RULES IN A CONSPICUOUS AREA OF THE VESSEL.

Payout Schedule 2010

WEIGHED BLUE MARLIN

Boats bringing a blue marlin to the docks will receive the balance of their entry level's Net Funds, limited to the three (3) heaviest Blue Marlin distributed as follows:

Heaviest Blue Marlin 100%	<i>IF NECESSARY</i>			
	1ST PLACE	60%	1ST PLACE	55%
	2ND PLACE	40%	2ND PLACE	35%
			3RD PLACE	10%

If more than 3 blue marlin are weighed, those ranking 4th in weight and higher will only receive the allotted one (1) point per pound toward their OVERALL POINTS. The minimum size for blue marlin is 105 inches in a line along the body from the fork of the tail to the tip of the lower jaw. 600 points will be assessed against a boat for each blue marlin brought to the dock not meeting the size requirement.

MEGAMARLIN

The first blue marlin weighed in that meets the minimum size requirement of 105 inches will win 100% of the net funds in this category.

Category will be judged on the first boat to arrive to the east end of the Megadock.

Participants must be entered in Level 1,2, or 3 of the Weighed Blue Marlin categories.

BILLFISH RELEASE

Points will be awarded in accordance with South Carolina Governor's Cup Rules as follows:

600 POINTS PER BLUE MARLIN RELEASE
 300 POINTS PER WHITE MARLIN RELEASE
 200 POINTS PER SAILFISH RELEASE

At the conclusion of the Tournament, the balance of the Net Funds of the Billfish Optional categories will be distributed as follows according to boats' entry level.

DAILY MEAT FISH

Percentage of the Net Funds will be awarded based on the heaviest Dolphin, Tuna, Wahoo weighed each day of the tournament as follows. The aggregate category will be paid on the heaviest combined weight of Dolphin, Tuna, and Wahoo daily and overall. Only one fish of each species may be weighed and two out of three species are required to be weighed for the aggregate category.

Tuna category does not include little tunny, bonita, or skipjack.

Thursday, July 8, 2010	20%	Saturday, July 10, 2010	20%
Friday, July 9, 2010	20%	Overall Heaviest	40%

MEGAFIFTY

The balance of this category will be divided evenly between all participants that weigh in a meat fish weighing 50 lbs or greater. Participants must be entered in one (1) of the Daily Meat Fish Categories.

LADY ANGLER WEIGHED FISH/RELEASE (Lady anglers must be 16 years of age or older)

50% of the Net Funds will be awarded based on the heaviest Dolphin, Tuna, Wahoo, Blue Marlin (105 inches) weighed in by a lady angler during the event.

Tuna category does not include little tunny, bonita, or skipjack.

50% of this category's Net Funds will be awarded to the individual lady angler that amasses the most billfish release points. The tie-breaker being the lady angler to reach their total points first. Billfish points will be awarded in accordance with South Carolina Governor's Cup Rules:

600 Blue Marlin, 300 White Marlin, 200 Sailfish.
